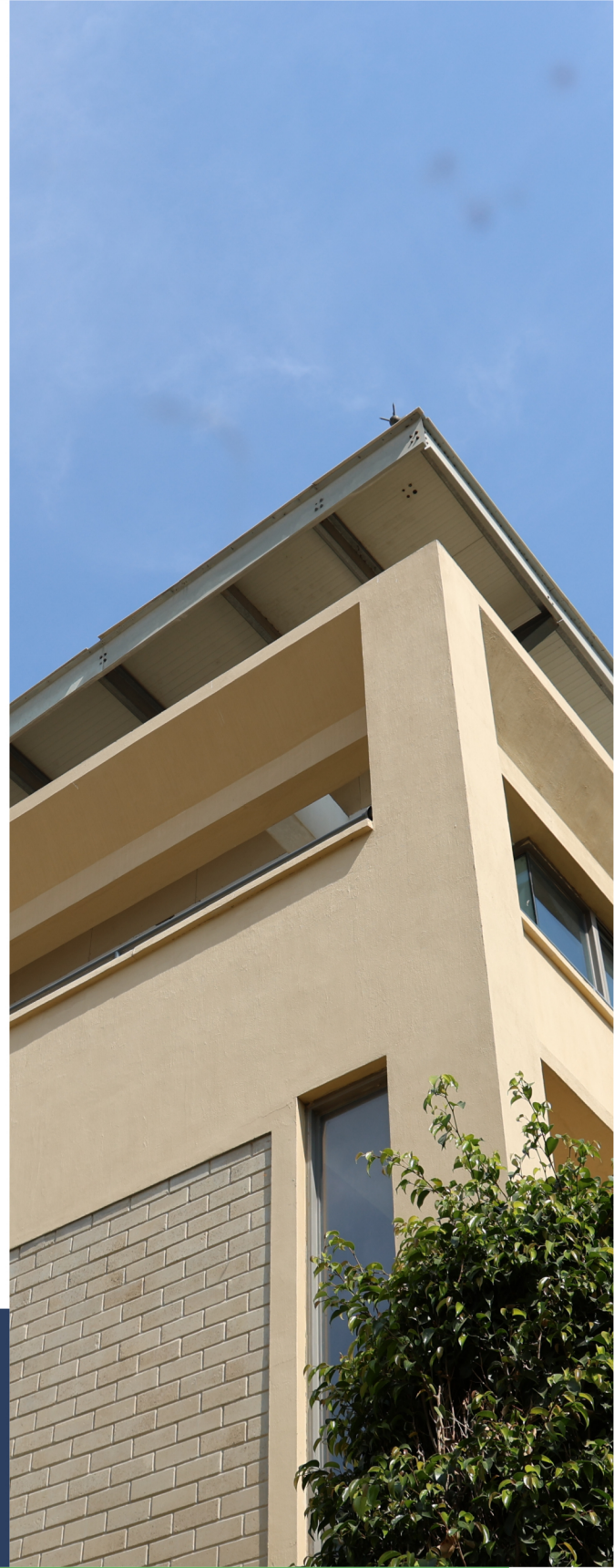
ABOUT NAMAL UNIVERSITY

What began as a bold vision on the shores of Namal Lake has grown into one of Pakistan's most inspiring educational success stories. Founded in 2008 by Imran Khan with a conviction that world-class education could transform rural Pakistan, Namal University Mianwali has steadily turned that conviction into reality.

Nestled against the breath-taking backdrop of the Salt Range, the university took its first steps as an affiliate college of the University of Bradford, UK with a single degree program, a handful of dreamers, and an unwavering sense of purpose. A decade later, in 2019, Namal earned its degree-awarding status, becoming Namal Institute. Then in 2021, the granting of a university charter officially turned it into Namal University, Mianwali.

Today, Namal stands as a merit-based institution offering four dynamic programs: Electrical Engineering, Business Administration, Computer Science, and Mathematics, each designed not just to educate but also to equip the next generation with the tools to tackle real-world, rural challenges through innovation and integrity.

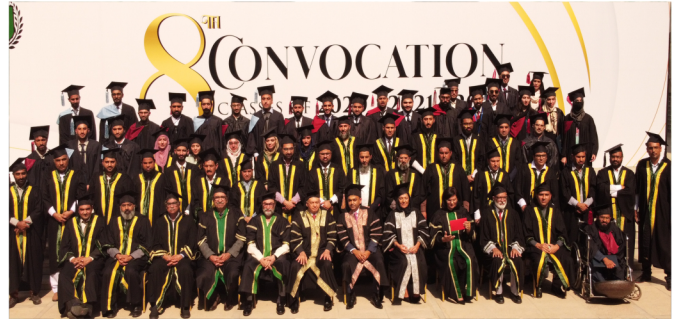

Over a decade, since the first graduating class walked out of Namal's gates, the alumni community has grown into a remarkable force. Over a thousand alumni spread across 34 countries on 4 continents, working in the world's most dynamic industries and institution. These numbers tell a story of impact, ambition, and the enduring power of a Namal education.

More than 660 alumni are now registered on the custom-built Namal Alumni Portal, accessing job listings, connecting with peers, and staying linked to the university they call home. The Namal Alumni Association has been formally chartered and democratically elected with a 15-member executive leadership structure already driving meaningful initiatives.

The most powerful measure of any university's success is what its graduates go on to do. By that measure, Namal stands tall. With an overall graduate employment rate of around 90% and 84% of the Class of 2025 placed within just three months of graduation, Namal alumni are proving their market readiness year after year.

They are not just employed, they are leading. Alumni serve as CEOs, Product Heads, Solution Architects, Senior Engineers, and Research Fellows in organizations spanning Pakistan and the globe. More than seventy alumni have chosen the path of public service, working in the Police department, FIA, NADRA, and WAPDA. Another 7% have taken the entrepreneurial route, building their own businesses and creating opportunities for others.

FROM NAMAL TO THE WORLD: THE GLOBAL FOOTPRINT

What began on a small campus near Namal Lake now echoes in boardrooms, research labs, and classrooms across the world. Namal alumni are present across multiple countries and continents, with the strongest concentrations in the GCC, the UK, and Europe. Saudi Arabia (21), United Arab Emirates (17), and the United Kingdom (16) lead the international distribution, followed by growing communities in Germany, Australia, the United States, and Canada.

Internationally, more than 92% of Namal alumni are employed, working at global organizations including Amazon, Nokia, Procter & Gamble, Fortinet, and the Barcelona Supercomputing Center. In terms of fields, the technology sector dominates, with 45% of alumni working in Software Development, followed by Engineering and Manufacturing (30%), Academic Research (15%), and Business and Management (10%).

PURSUIT OF HIGHER EDUCATION & SPECIALIZATION

A significant portion of alumni have pursued or are pursuing postgraduate qualifications. Numerous alumni have completed or are enrolled in MS/Masters programs across the US, UK, Europe, and Australia. At least 15+ alumni have obtained or are currently pursuing a PhD. This is a powerful indicator of the strong research foundation and academic curiosity instilled at the undergraduate level. Alumni are studying at world-renowned universities like Cornell University, University of Ottawa, Technical University of Berlin (TU Berlin), Tampere University, and Australian National University.



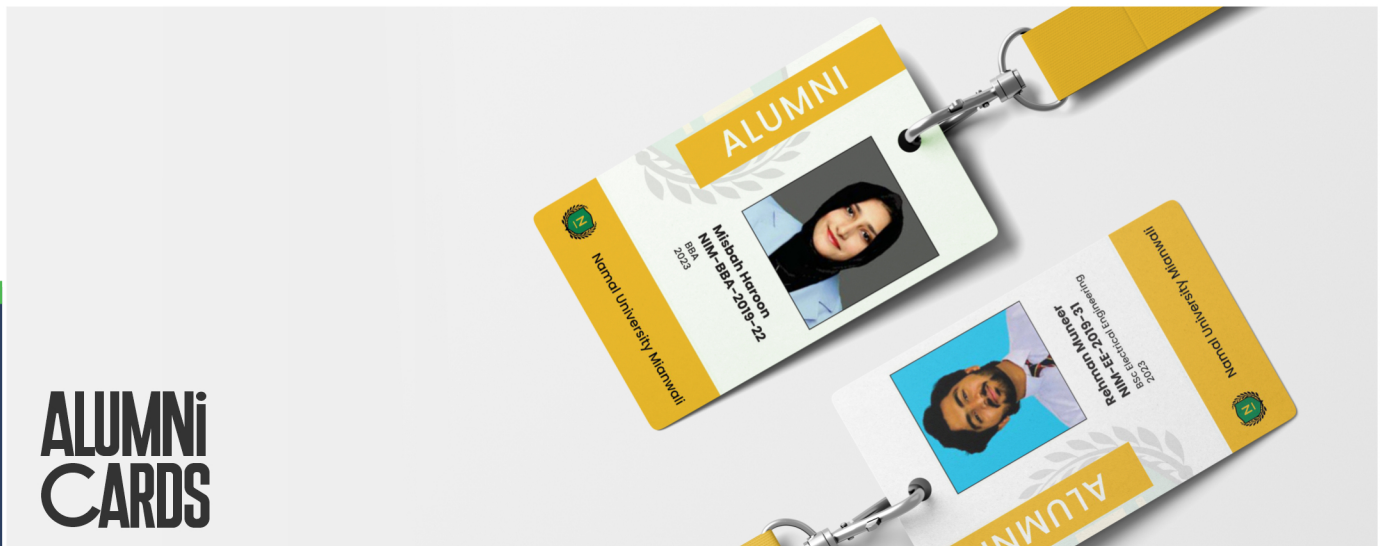
UNIVERSITY DEVELOPMENTS

This has been a year of steady, meaningful progress for Namal University. The inauguration of regional chapters in Lahore and Islamabad, the establishment of a formal alumni association with elected leadership following the first democratic e-voting process, and a homecoming that welcomed over 120 graduates back to campus – all these milestones demonstrate that the bonds formed at Namal endure well beyond graduation. A dedicated alumni portal is now live and steadily growing, reflecting the university's commitment to strengthening connections and building systems that support its community.

On the outcomes front, Namal continues to produce career-ready graduates. The overall employment rate stands at 90%, with the Class of 2025 achieving 84% placement within three months of graduation. Beyond statistics, it is the impact of our alumni that truly inspires. From cloud engineering roles in Islamabad to semiconductor design projects across Taiwan and Europe, Namalites are leading, innovating, and competing at the highest levels.

DIGITAL ALUMNI INFRASTRUCTURE

A custom-built Namal Alumni Portal was launched, enabling 660+ registered alumni to access job listings, engage in networking, and stay connected with university communications. Official alumni email IDs were issued to reinforce institutional identity. A biannual data update system ensures that all alumni records remain accurate and actionable.

CAMPUS INFRASTRUCTURE AND ALUMNI VISITS SOPs

Namal University continues to expand its campus to support a vibrant residential community. A centerpiece of this development is the state-of-the-art multi-purpose Namal Sports Facility, designed to foster student growth, promote a culture of sports and wellness, and enhance the university's visibility at regional and national levels.

To ensure smooth and well-organized alumni visits, a comprehensive set of Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) has been introduced for alumni visits. These guidelines ensure smooth and organized visits, covering accommodation, reservations through the alumni portal, guest accompaniment, and adherence to a code of conduct aligned with Namal's values.



INDUSTRY MOUs AND CORPORATE PARTNERSHIPS

The 11th Open House and 2nd Career Fair 2025 brought over 45 companies to campus, creating valuable recruitment and networking opportunities for students. A key milestone was the signing of an MoU with Servis Group of Companies, facilitated through a Namal alumna, reflecting the growing role of the alumni network in strengthening institutional partnerships. The collaboration also included a campus recruitment seminar and the launch of an ambassador program.

In addition, recruitment drives were conducted by Systems Limited, Mavericks United, and Challenges Apparel, while alumni represented organizations such as 10x Engineers, InvoZone, Septem Systems, and Tixel also participated, further strengthening industry engagement through alumni connections.



ALUMNi TALK SERIES

One of the most impactful initiatives of the Alumni & Placement Office, the Namal Alumni Talk Series brings accomplished graduates back to campus, in person and virtually, to share professional journeys, industry knowledge, and career guidance with current students. The 2025–2026 edition featured more than five compelling sessions spanning power engineering, emerging technology, semiconductor design, career planning, and entrepreneurship.

NAMAL ALUMNi ASSOCIATION (NAA)

The Namal Alumni Association (NAA) was formally constituted in 2025 – marking the first time Namal's graduate community has had a structured, democratically elected representative body. The NAA Charter was approved on 7 November 2025. Elections conducted via e-voting on 12 April 2025 returned a 9-member Executive Committee, with 6 Batch Representatives added by by-election in November 2025. The NAA Steering Committee (NAASC) was constituted to oversee strategy and electoral integrity, while regional chapters were successfully launched in Lahore (March 2025) and Islamabad (January 2026), bringing the alumni network closer to where most graduates live and work. In its very first year, the Association made its mark in a tangible way, raising PKR 240,000 for graduate professional training through the 10x Engineers collaboration at CAID, setting the tone for a self-sustaining, alumni-driven future.

"My journey towards higher education began long before I entered a research lab. It began at Namal, the initial lap of my academic race. It was at Namal that I realized a PhD is the one degree in the world I was meant to pursue, a path where curiosity turns into contribution.

Namal didn't just teach me; it ignited a spark in me. It gave me purpose, direction, and the courage to dream beyond boundaries. That spark carried me to Italy, where in September 2022, I completed my PhD in Applied Data Sciences from the University of L'Aquila, becoming the first PhD graduate to emerge from Namal. And today, with gratitude and pride, I am serving as an Assistant Professor at the University of Buckingham, UK. My story is simple: start where you are, believe in what ignites you, and let that spark take you further than you ever imagined."

"I worked at Namal in various rural development projects from 2014 to 2017, and published my undergrad final-year project in a top-tier journal. Those years at Namal not only sharpened my technical skills but also helped me become an independent researcher. Recently, I completed my PhD in Computer Science from one of the top-ranked universities in global rankings, City University of Hong Kong (QS# 63, THE#73) with full scholarships, presented my work at international conferences, and secured research and travel grants. I was also a research trainee at Harvard Medical School in 2023-24, where I had the opportunity to learn from leading research groups in cancer treatment development at Brigham and Women's Hospital and Massachusetts General Hospital. BE Computer Science – Class of 2020

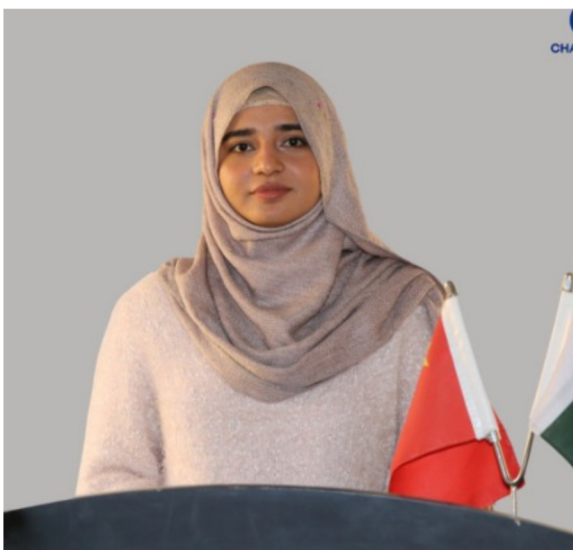
